Looking Back at the Inauguration of TPI

This year marks our **15th Anniversary of Training Pastors International (TPI)** since the inauguration of TPI when Jennifer and I started the ministry on March 15, 2002, as a result of the burgeoning need for pastoral training in the Majority World. Two years previous to that date (2000), Dr. Stephen F. Olford of Olford Ministries International, who was my mentor since I wrote my Th.M. thesis at Dallas Theological Seminary (1982) on his preaching ministry and served with him in his pastoral training ministry, commissioned me to launch TPI when I was the Associate Director of the Stephen Olford Institute of Biblical Preaching in Memphis, Tennessee. Then I came to Liberty University in Lynchburg, Virginia (2000) to head up the Missions Program on the grad and undergrad levels and also oversee the Global Center for World Missions. During my tenure there, Dr. Jerry Falwell, Sr., the founder of Liberty University and Thomas Road Baptist Church, challenged me to start TPI and offered his help to launch this critical

ministry of training indigenous pastors in Africa.

We started training pastors with TPI in Ghana in June 2002, and now, we are training pastors in 20 countries in Africa, soon to add our 21st country this summer in Sierra Leone, and have also launched TPI in Asia (India and Nepal) in 2016, and have trained pastors in 7 other countries for a total of 28 countries, including Africa, Asia, Latin America, the former Soviet Union, and the Caribbean. Since 1993, the total figures to date for our pastoral training mission in Majority World countries encompasses the following statistics, which includes nine years of training pastors before we started TPI: **we have conducted 149 pastoral training institutes, trained 28,292 pastors, evangelists, church planters, and national missionaries, and awarded 15,040 certificates by taking 46 Mission Trips to these 28 countries.**

As we look to the next 10 to 15 years, the greatest need in missions today is the

training of indigenous pastors in Majority World countries since about **95% of the world's pastors in these countries have little to no Biblical training as a foundation for their ministries.** Unless you complete the church planting movement cycle by doing (1) evangelism, (2) church planting, and (3) training pastors, it will produce a retardation of the church planting movement in that country, the Majority World churches will not be able to carry out the Great Commission in their countries, and will instead end up in a malaise of false teaching in many different forms as is the case right now around the world. With that in mind, we are planning to conduct 6 TPI institutes in Africa this summer (Liberia, Sierra Leone, Rwanda, Democratic Republic of Congo, Malawi, and Zambia), and 4 TPI institutes in Asia in the Fall (India [2], Nepal, and Myanmar).

We thank God for those who are partnering with us in prayer and support to make this a reality so we can offer this pastoral training to these pastors.

TPI Summer Mission Trip: July 14 to August 29, 2017

We are planning to conduct 6 pastoral training institutes for approximately 1400 national pastors in Africa.

John and Jennifer Balmer from Lynchburg, Virginia, will be conducting six institutes in West Africa (Liberia and Sierra Leone), East Africa (Rwanda), Central Africa (DR Congo), and Southern Africa (Malawi and Zambia). John will be joined by (1) Rev. Nick Prieto in Kakata, Liberia; (2) Pastor Bob Ferguson in Freetown, Sierra Leone; (3) Pastor Wally Gilmer in Cyangugu, Rwanda; (4) Pastor Sam Kunju Mathai from Mumbai, India, in Fizi, DR Congo and Kasungu, Malawi; and

(5) Jennifer Balmer in Kabwe, Zambia. We will also be joined by our local coordinators: (1) Pastor Oliver Kpaan from Liberia; (2) Pastor Raymond Gobum from Nigeria; (3) Pastor Emmanuel Rutunda from Rwanda; (4) Pastor Nepa Wa Msambelwa from the DR Congo; (5) Pastor Glyn D. Mittawa from Malawi; and

(6) Pastor Bilex Mutale from Zambia.
